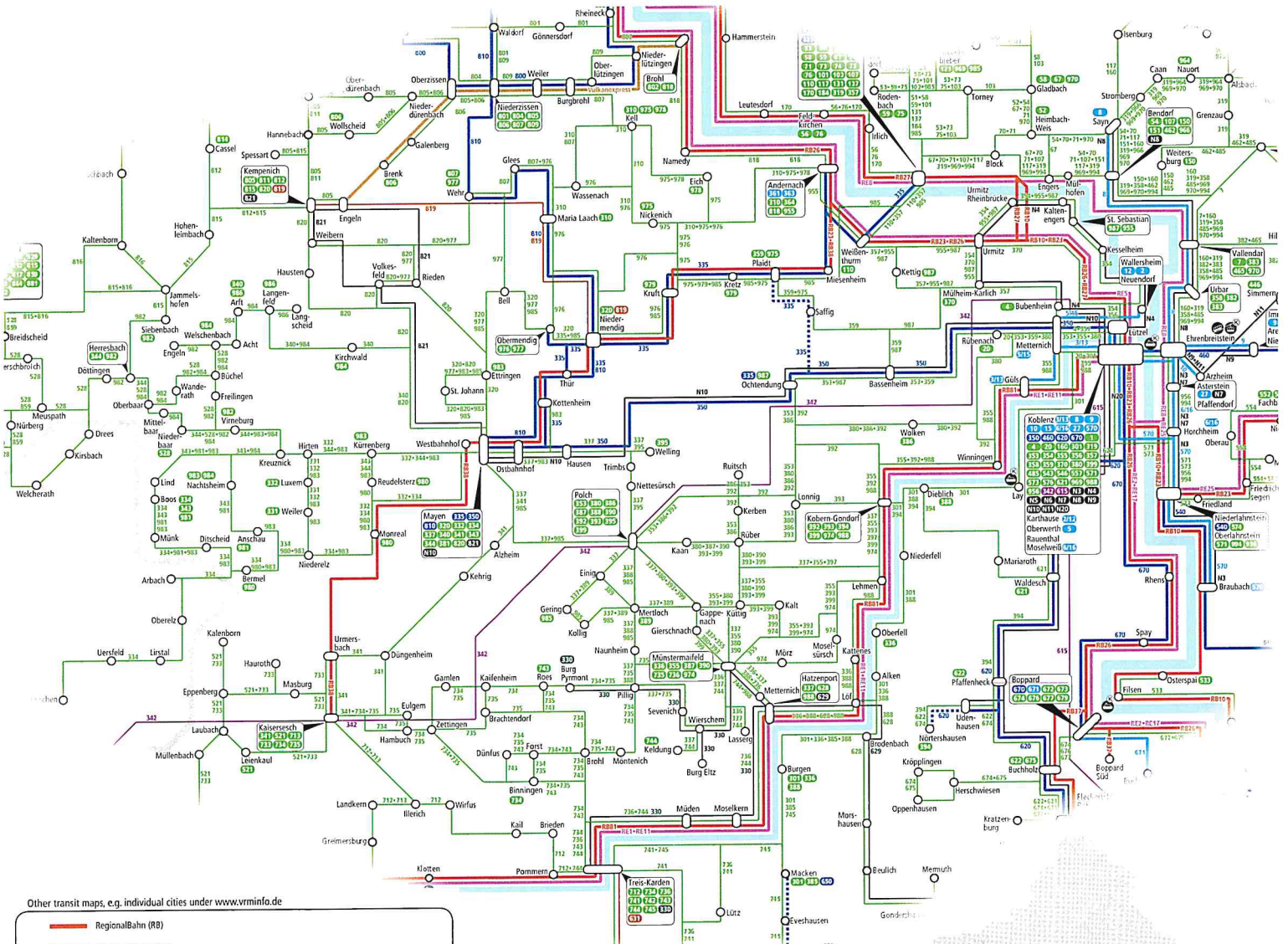


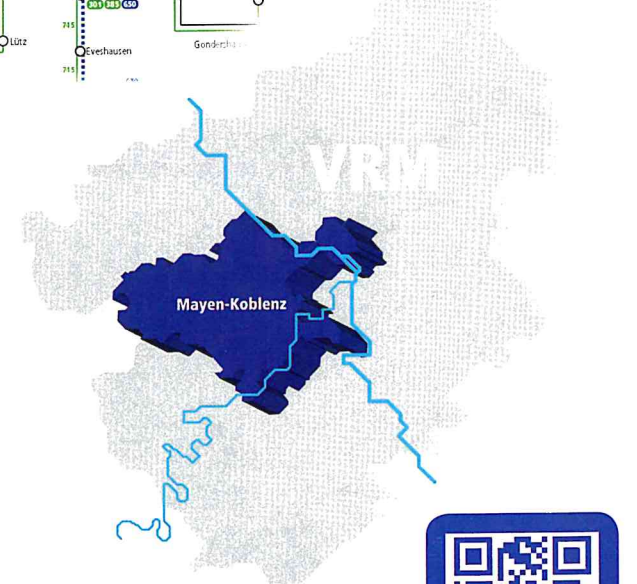


# Transit map detail Mayen-Koblenz



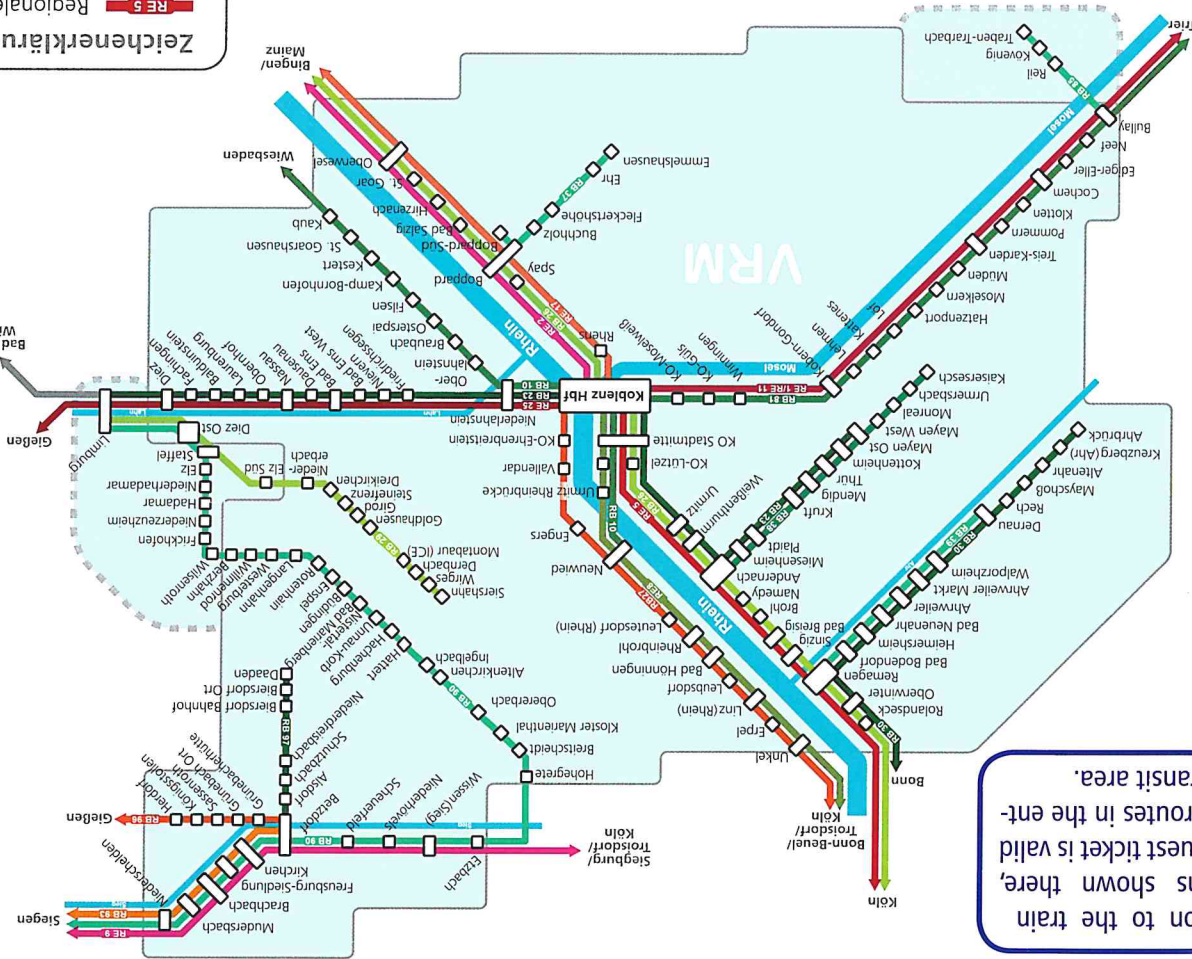

DETAILS ABOUT THE VRM-GÄSTETICKET



**For what period is the VRM-Gästeticket (VRM guest ticket) valid?**

The accommodation services within the VRM region participating in the VRM-Gästeticket scheme provide a special service for you during your stay! You will receive a VRM-Gästeticket from your accommodation service. The ticket holder is entitled to free use of local public transport within the VRM region. The VRM-Gästeticket is valid for the duration of your stay in the VRM. Only the data entered by your host shall be valid.

**Can the VRM guest ticket be transferred?**

Your individual VRM-Gästeticket card is not transferable; only you personally may use the advantages provided by the ticket during your stay.

**Is it also possible to purchase a VRM-Gästeticket?**

No, the VRM-Gästeticket cannot be purchased. You can only receive it from your host.

**Is there anything else to be observed?**

Please carry the VRM-Gästeticket and this leaflet with you at all times during your stay, as well as a valid photo ID. Each person must hold a guest ticket.

**Terms of use for Bus & Train**

1. The VRM-Gästeticket is valid only for local public transport of the VRM (in 2nd class train carriages – not in Inter City or Inter City Express trains).
  2. The VRM-Gästeticket is only valid when fully completed (the name and the place of residence of the guest must be entered along with the arrival and departure date). If the departure date has not been decided on in advance, your host will enter the expected date of your departure. If you should stay longer than expected, you will receive a new VRM-Gästeticket. Subsequent changes to the VRM-Gästeticket make it invalid for any use as an authorisation to public transport.
  3. The VRM-Gästeticket is valid for passenger transport. The transport of bicycles is free of charge on weekdays after 09:00 and all day on Sundays and public holidays – insofar as the capacity of the trains or buses allows it.
  4. The relevant tariff regulations of the Rhein-Mosel (VRM) transport association relating to the transportation of animals apply. If they are carried in closed boxes transport is free, otherwise a reduced single ticket must be purchased for the respective travel distance.

Please also note: When leaving the VRM area by bus or train, you have to purchase a so-called Anschlusssticket (= connecting ticket).
